Golf Rule of the Week

Putt strikes player's foot

During a stroke play competition, a player made a stroke at his ball while on the green and missed the hole, but then the ball rolled on and hit his foot, which was behind the hole. Does the golfer incur a penalty or does he play ball from where it finishes?

Answer

Exception 2 to Rule 11.1b tells us that when a ball played from on the putting green accidentally hits any person (including the player putting the ball), the player must replace a ball (the original or another ball) on its original spot and replay the putt. If the original spot is not precisely known, the player must estimate it. There is no penalty, and the stroke that hit the foot does not count.

If this were to occur anywhere except on the putting green, the ball would have to be played as it lies [Rule 11.1b].
