

ROUND 14 – Saturday August 3 – Match Report AJAX vs Old Camberwell



On the big wide spaces at the Gordon Barnard Reserve in Balwyn, the Jackas relished the conditions and after a slow start made the most of the first quarter's inside 50's, kicking 4 goals to 1 for the quarter.

Forwards Dov Paltiel and Brandon Joel were running a-muck, with 2 goals to Joel for the term.

The Jackas frustrated coach Adam Andrews early in the second quarter, having all the play but were unable to convert. It wasn't until the 12th minute of the quarter that the Jackas put on another major, when Jake Lew kicked truly from a set shot. The ball was moving between the half back lines at a fast pace, with a great Toby Sheezel smother, a strong contested mark by Justin Berkowitz while Asher Burstin, Charlie Hamilton and Brad Caplan were all racking up the possessions.

Jake Lew was then asked to play an unfamiliar role in the ruck and he left the other forwards to put on some more majors as Joel kicked a great running goal followed by a goal to Stuart Fayman from a mark, one of his 13 marks for the day. The Jackas lead by 32 points at the main break.

Coach Andrews acknowledged the great job of the defenders in the first half, as they repelled a number of inside 50 entries from the hosts.

The pattern continued in the third quarter as the Jackas couldn't put goals on early, with the first major to Old Camberwell before Lew, playing back in the forward line, kicked his third following a down the field hit on skipper, Nick Lewis.

A great snap goal to Alex Wollan from clever roving, a fourth goal to Joel from a set shot, another from Benji Krongold from a set shot and then one to Kane Nissenbaum from the pocket and the Jackas raced away to a 50 point margin at 3/4 time.

Fayman was up to his old tricks with a sneaky little handball to Richie Simon instead of taking the set shot for another major and Krongold put the exclamation mark on the win by kicking his second major at the 19 minute mark.

The Jackas kicked 2.7 in the last quarter to complete a solid win by 59 points, taking the team to fifth, just one game and percentage outside of the top 4. They play 3rd placed Old Ivanhoe at Albert Park this week to try and sneak closer to finals contention.

Major possession winner for the Jackas were Paltiel 35, Hamilton 33, Caplan 32 and Fayman 30.
