Member Protection & Code of Conduct

- ▶ All participants (and parents) have agreed to abide by the Carnival Code of Conduct.

 - ▶ Weapons

- ▶ Serious offenses will result in children being sent home at their parents expense.

- ▶ No Carnival participants will be permitted to take public transport, taxis or Ubers for the duration of Carnival.

- ▶ **Consequences** - depending on the nature of the post/message and its level of offence, you may be omitted from Carnival, ID taken away, and for interstate participants, you may be sent home at your parent's expense.
